Legacy Village is a first-class lifestyle center, designed to offer the best in shopping, dining and entertainment. All of our buildings, as well as the streets here, are privately owned. We reserve the right to define the rules of conduct acceptable for admission to our property. While here, we ask that you treat others as you would wish to be treated.

For the safety and enjoyment of all Legacy Village visitors, please read and observe the following:

The conduct listed below is considered unacceptable at Legacy Village. These are all behaviors which may cause inconvenience to others or are considered ill-mannered and/or disrespectful:

- › Running, horseplay, tag, scavenger hunts, wrestling and fighting.
- › After 9:00 pm, minors under the age of sixteen (16) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 21.
- › Loud or unnecessary noises which annoy, disturb or endanger the comfort, peace or safety of others within Legacy Village. This includes yelling, screaming, the use of foul language and the playing of loud music.
- › Congregating in large groups and blocking sidewalks, walkways, store fronts or balconies from other guests.
- › Playing on escalators/elevators, climbing on fixtures, posts, pillars, walls or trees.
- › Skating/rollerblading, skateboarding, riding bicycles or scooters on sidewalks or through pedestrian areas.
- › Littering, throwing items from balconies, creating disruptions in public restrooms and common areas.
- › Rude or abusive disturbances, which include being purposely noisy, boisterous, rude and insulting toward any other person with the intent to abuse or annoy others.
- › Solicitation of any kind. This includes the distribution of any type of political or religious materials and/or petitioning of any kind.
- › Smoking is prohibited in all common areas of Legacy Village.
- › Having open containers of alcohol outside the premises of a restaurant or restaurant patio in which drinking alcohol is permitted.
- › Car stereos playing too loudly.
- › Appropriate attire must be worn at all times. No offensive messages or pictures may be displayed on clothing.
- › No overnight parking.
- › Moving, dragging or rearranging any outdoor furniture including tables, chairs, umbrellas, umbrella stands, planters, art work or benches.
- › Any other activity deemed as inappropriate by Legacy Village Public Safety.
