FOR THE SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT OF ALL LEGACY VILLAGE VISITORS, PLEASE READ AND OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING CODE OF CONDUCT.

Legacy Village is a premier lifestyle center, designated to offer the best in shopping, dining and entertainment. All the buildings and streets are privately owned. Legacy Village reserves the right to define the rules of conduct acceptable for admission to the property. Failure to respond to reasonable requests or directions from property staff, Legacy Village Site Security personnel or law enforcement is grounds for immediate removal from the property. Violators of these codes may be subject for expulsion, banning, arrest and/or prosecution for criminal trespass.

THE CONDUCT LISTED BELOW IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED:

- Loud or unnecessary noises which annoy, disturb, or endanger the comfort, peace, or safety of others including, but not limited to, yelling, screaming, the use of foul language and playing loud music
- Rude or abusive disturbances, which include being boisterous, rude, and insulting toward any other person with the intent to abuse or annoy
- > Littering, throwing items from balconies, creating disruptions in public restrooms or common areas
- > Inappropriate attire including offensive messages/pictures, visible undergarments, gang signs and symbols, or clothing that obscures the face (excluding PPE masks for safety)
- > Possession of any item that could be used as a weapon including, but not limited to, firearms, explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks, knives or any other item that may be used to inflict injury
- > Congregating in large groups and blocking sidewalks, walkways, store fronts or balconies from other guests
- > Playing on escalators/elevators, climbing on fixtures, posts, pillars, walls, or trees
- Running, horseplay, tag, wrestling, fighting or unauthorized scavenger hunts
- › Skating/rollerblading, skateboarding, riding bicycles, hoverboards or scooters on sidewalks or through pedestrian areas
- Operating drones
- Solicitation, picketing, leafleting of any kind including, but not limited to, any type of political or religious materials
- Smoking in common areas, which includes cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapor cigarettes and all illegal substances
- Moving, dragging, or rearranging any outdoor furniture, planters, or artwork
- Inappropriate vehicle behavior including, but not limited to, double parking, waiting in fire lanes or loading docks, loud car stereos, or spinning tires, cruising, speeding, overnight parking, or parking outside of designated parking spaces
- Minors under 17 years of age without a parent or guardian over the age of 21 after 9 p.m.
- Any illegal activity
- › Any other activity deemed as inappropriate by Legacy Village Staff or Site Security

DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA (DORA) GUIDELINES:

- > Visitors age 21 and over may purchase and carry alcohol from DORA participating restaurants if the following guidelines are followed:
 - Participate during the active DORA hours of 11 a.m. and 9:30 p.m.
 - o Stay within designated DORA boundary shown on DORA printed materials and on Legacy Village's website
 - Purchase alcohol from participating restaurants and use the approved DORA plastic cup
 - o DORA beverages can be enjoyed within select retailers that have a logo on their door
 - All State of Ohio and City of Lyndhurst laws regarding public intoxication, impaired driving and open containers apply to areas both inside and outside of the DORA boundaries
 - o Drink responsibly and maintain appropriate behavior

PET POLICY:

- > Legacy Village welcomes guests with well-behaved leashed dogs if the following guidelines are followed:
 - Use designated common areas for dogs that include clean-up bags and waste receptacles
 - o Please clean up after your dog
 - Always keep your dog on a leash/in a carrier and under your supervision
 - Ensure your dog has current vaccinations and appropriate tags
 - o Only enter retailers and restaurants that have a logo in their front window
- Legacy Village and all its retailers and restaurants reserve the right to ask guests to remove their dog from the premises if it is determined that the behavior of the dog is causing a disturbance to others
- > Retailers and restaurants may have their own policies and have the right to enforce them as they see fit
